Non-UNC Undergraduates seeking to enroll in graduate-level courses

This could take up to 4 weeks to evaluate, so plan accordingly. To do this:

Non-UNC undergraduate status refers to bachelor's degree-seeking juniors and seniors, who are not enrolled at the University of Northern Colorado, who have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and are interested in taking graduate-level classes. Students to submit official transcripts to UNC in order to verify your eligibility to enroll for graduate credits.
