#### **Course Description**

The Storytellers workshop will focus on the following skills and knowledge through interactive presentations

- Culturally responsive teaching in the choral classroom
- Working with neuro-diverse populations in the choral classroom
- Strategies for selecting and performing diverse repertoire
- Community-building practices in the choral classroom

# **Course Objectives**

- Students will participate in presentations focused on equitable classroom practices.
- Students will reflect on the application of equitable classroom practices in their own classrooms and create a plan to implement the strategies the learned in the workshop

# **Rationale for Graduate Credit:**
