## **Course Description**

This Estill Voice Training course for teachers includes the following components:

- Attendance at Estill Voice Training June 5-8, 9am-5p
- Application of vocal techniques in classroom teaching scenarios.
- Reflection entries detailing how techniques learned are applied in teaching.
- Final project demonstrating implementation and effectiveness of Estill techniques in the classroom.

## **Course Objectives**

- Demonstrate an understanding of vocal anatomy function
- Learn Estill Voice Training techniques applicable to teaching.
- Apply vocal techniques effectively in classroom teaching.
- Reflect critically on the effectiveness of vocal technique implementation.

## **Grading Method: P/F Grade**

To earn a Passing (P) grade, students must achieve the following:

- 100% attendance at all training sessions.
- Complete reflection entries following each session.
- Submit a final project that includes repertoire selection and rehearsal plans applying the techniques from the course
